BY-LAW No. 735

Civic Holiday – Toonik Tyme

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit to declare a civic holiday within the boundaries of Iqaluit, Nunavut.

WHEREAS Section 129(b) of the *Cities, Towns and Villages Act*, S. Nu. 2003, c.2., provides for Municipal Councils to declare civic holidays within the limits of the community;

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provision of the *Cities Towns and Villages Act*, and notwithstanding any by-law, sections thereof, resolutions or prior enactments, the Council of the City of Iqaluit in session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Friday during the week of Toonik Tyme is declared a full day Civic Holiday to enable the employed to participate in Toonik Tyme festivities.
2. THAT By-laws 163 and 548 are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This By-Law shall come into effect upon third and final reading.
