BY-LAW # 606

CONFIRMATORY BY-LAW

A By-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of Iqaluit in Nunavut to confirm proceedings of the Council of the City of Iqaluit pursuant to the Cities Towns and Villages Act, S.Nu. 2003.

WHEREAS Section 9 of the Cities Towns and Villages Act, 1988, as amended, provides that the powers and duties of a municipal corporation are to be exercised and performed by the council.

AND WHEREAS Section 10(1) of the Cities Towns and Villages Act provides that Council shall exercise its powers and perform its duties by resolution or by by-law.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the resolutions of the Council of the City of Iqaluit at this meeting be confirmed and adopted by by-law;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Iqaluit enacts as follows:

1. The action of the Council of the City of Iqaluit in respect of each recommendation contained in Engineering and Planning Committee of the Whole minutes dated March 15, 2005, the Public Works Committee of the Whole minutes dated March 14, 2005, each motion and resolution passed and other action taken by the Council of the City of Iqaluit at this meeting is hereby adopted and confirmed as if such proceedings were expressly embodied in this by-law.
2. The Mayor and appropriate officials of the City of Iqaluit are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the action of the Council of the City of Iqaluit referred to in the proceeding section.
3. The Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer or in the absence of the Chief Administrative officer their delegate, are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix thereto the corporate seal of the City of Iqaluit.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This By-law shall come into effect the date upon third and final reading.
